Session 1

Measure to Manage (and Achieve!) Your Financial Stewardship Goals

The 2023 Stewardship Survey, conducted by Vision2 and CSN, revealed a disconnect between setting actionable goals and taking relevant steps to meet and measure against those goals. For example, more than half of the Survey's webinar attendees reported they do not track their financial discipleship efforts. Join this session for actionable best practices on setting goals for both stewardship and generosity, measuring your progress, and creating the necessary accountability in your stewardship role.
